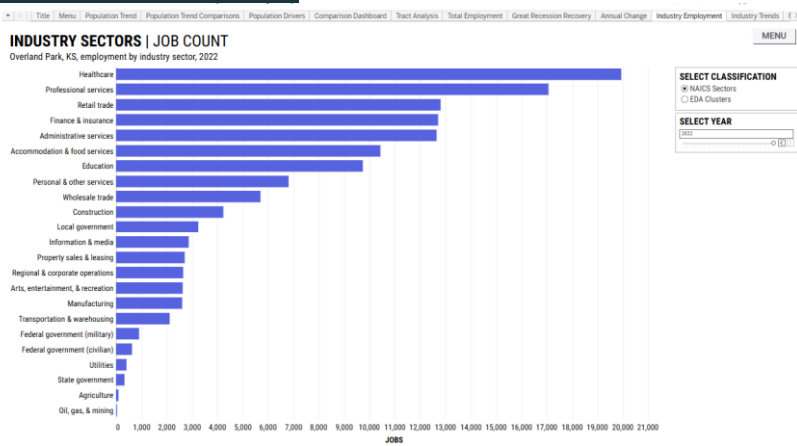
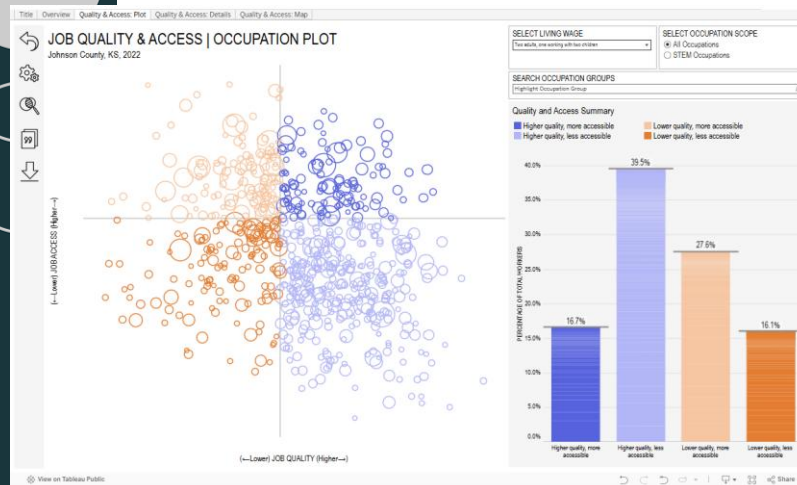

It was a busy **week** of floor action. Both chambers debated dozens of bills before adjourning on Thursday evening.

Legislation approved by both chambers in identical form is going to Governor Kelly for her consideration. Conference committees will be appointed to negotiate the differences if the chambers have differing versions of the same bill.

Conference committees consist of three lawmakers from each chamber—two from the majority party and one from the minority party. These members will negotiate on behalf of their respective chambers to reconcile differences.
